COSTS AND PAYMENT POLICIES

All fees go towards teaching, venue costs and administration. Rose Youth Theatre is a not-for-profit charity. All fees must be paid in advance of your child's first class. If you fail to pay by the deadline, we may release your child's place and offer it to someone else.

Sibling Discount

We can offer a 25% sibling discount - if you have two or more children attending a Rose Youth Theatre course, the cheapest course will be reduced. Please let us know when you book if you'd like the discount. This discount is only applicable to one set of fees.

Bursary Scheme

We have never turned anyone away for not being able to cover fees.

If it's difficult to pay the fee, inclusion and opportunities for all are at the heart of what we do at Rose Participate. Bursaries are available on request to help cover the cost of courses for those who may struggle with the fees. While anyone is free to apply for the bursary fund to help support participation, priority will be given to those facing financial hardship. Bursaries will be offered to fully or partially cover course fees. Mentoring and support are also offered alongside financial support. Re-enrolment

Most groups are capped at 15 students per class, and places are offered on a first-come first-served basis. Those already enrolled are offered a one-week priority booking period but must register again at the start of every term. We have a waiting list if your desired group is currently at capacity.

Cancellation Policy

We cannot offer refunds (unless under exceptional circumstances) if you decide to cancel your place after the start of term, or for missed sessions. We understand absences and changes in schedules are sometimes unavoidable, however the hire of our venues and staff relies solely on the course fees and therefore affects all members.
